Texas Shootout Rules – Can Assist Charity Day

- Names of the 4 players and their handicaps on the card.
- Each team consists of 4 players. EACH PLAYER MUST USE 4 TEE SHOTS INCLUDING A PAR THREE. All 4 tee off and the best tee shot is chosen remembering that each player must use 4 tee shots each.
- All players play their next shot from that point. Ball to be placed 30cms from the chosen ball, no nearer the hole on the fairway and 15cms on the green.
- For the remainder of the hole each player plays their own ball as a stableford.

Scoring: The 2 best stableford scores are recorded on the card.

- AGM: Due to Covid restrictions we will not be having an AGM meeting this year. Most of the presentations
 such as Vets and Medals have not been contested so there will be no annual presentations. Nomination forms
 will be in the ladies rooms early November. All nominations to be returned by the 24th November. In the case
